Wed., May 6: Des Moines, IA We depart on this fun Spring Getaway to the Amana Colonies and the 84th Annual Pella Tulip Festival. Comfort and meal stops will be made along the way. This afternoon we'll stop in Clear Lake, IA at the **Surf Ballroom** for a tour. This is the place where Richie Valens, Buddy Holly, the Big Bopper, and Dion entertained fans before "the Day the Music Died." Our destination is **Des Moines IA**, for a two-night stay. The evening is on your own.

Thurs., May 7: Des Moines, IA (B, D) Tulip Festival ~ Des Moines, IA (B, D) We arrive in Pella, IA, this morning looking forward to a full schedule of Tulip Festival activities. Enjoy the beautiful displays of tulips of every color while we go on a guided tour of this Dutch community. We will also visit the Historical Village Museum to see the Boyhood Home of Wyatt Earp, the Gristmill, and more. You will also see the Klokkenspel, a 147-bell Carillon where mechanical figures perform to music. There will also be time to shop, browse, and have lunch on your own. We will have general admission seats for the afternoon festivities. At 1:00pm the Grandstand show will feature Dutch dancing and singing, Parade of Provinces (Dutch costume style show), presentation of the Queen and her Court, the famous street scrubbing and more. And then a highlight of the Tulip Time Festival is the parade at 2:30 pm with bands from the area plus many floats decked out with Dutch themes, the Royal Court and more. After the Parade we will go Central College for the Dutch Dinner Show & Entertainment. The traditional Dutch meal has Dutch Spiced Beef, Roast Pork Loin, Hut Spot (smashed potatoes, carrots & onions), Rode Kool (red cabbage), Snibontjes (green beans w/bacon drippings), Dutch Lettuce (sweet & tangy dressing), Mixed Fresh Fruit, Rolls (Hard Rolls & Honey Wheat), Apple Cake w/Pecan Caramel Sauce, and iced tea/coffee/ice water. Entertainment will be provided by the Tulip Queen and Court. We will then return to our hotel in Des Moines.

#### PELLA TULIP FESTIVAL

Be our guest for the 85th annual Tulip Time celebration! This family-friendly event is being 7-9, 2020 and features parades, Dutch costumes and demonstrations, performances, a craft and vendor fair, quilt and flower shows, and beautiful tulip gardens! All of these activities are set in picturesque Pella, Iowa, a charming Dutch community with parks and architecture reminiscent of historic Netherlands.

#### HISTORICAL VILLAGE MUSEUM

Adjoining the windmill is the Historical Village with colorful flower gardens and a complex of 22 buildings that depict home life in Pella from pioneer days to the early 20th century. The miniature Dutch Village, with over 100 buildings replicating villages in Holland, is a delight to all.

Inside the Historical Village, you'll see...

- -The Boyhood Home of Wyatt Earp
- -The Beason-Blommers Mill and Blacksmith Shop
- -The Log Cabin, moved piece by piece from a local farm
- -The Werkplaats, the place where wooden shoes are made
- -The Sterrenberg Library and Delft House, which houses an extensive antique Delft collection
- -Scholte Church, a replica of Dominie Scholte's first church in Pella
- -Heritage Hall, which houses precious antiques, costumes, and vignettes of Dutch daily life, as well as Goliath, our authentic Dutch street organ
- -The Bakery, completely refurbished as a working bakery of the 1850s
- -The Meat and Cheese Shop, a tribute to the legacy of Pella's meat markets
- -The Sod House, a replica of the housing of Pella's pioneers during their early years
- ...and much more. exhibits that the Historical Village offers.

#### BOYHOOD HOME OF WYATT EARP

Pella is home to one of the most famous (or infamous?) characters of the Old West. Wyatt Earp moved with his family to Pella in 1850, when Wyatt was 2 years old, from Monmouth, Illinois. For 14 years the Earp family farmed in the Pella area, and Wyatt's father, Nicholas Earp, worked as a recruiter for the Union Army. The boyhood home of Wyatt Earp and his family still stands in its original location as part of the Historical Village.

#### KLOKKENSPEL

Eight four-foot mechanical figures perform at regular intervals to the music of a 147-bell computer driven carillon. This is one of only a handful of animated musical clocks in the United States.

#### **GRANDSTAND SHOW & STREET SCRUBBING**

Although the parade can be viewed from anywhere along the route, the best way to see the parade is from the Grandstand. Our Grandstand tickets will not only provide you with a reserved seat for the parade, but a perfect seat for viewing the Grandstand show, which begins 90 minutes prior to parade time. The afternoon Grandstand show features Dutch dancing and singing, a Dutch costume style show, cheese market demonstration, presentation of the Tulip Queen and her Court, and the famous street scrubbers.

The parades are a big hit at Tulip Time! The 2:30 pm parade features elaborate floats, marching bands, and residents in authentic Dutch costume!
