It spans 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high. You will learn about the life of Noah, how he and his family could have fit in the Ark, how they cared for the animals on the Ark, and how his life was before the flood. A must-see, and is enjoyed by young and old alike. Lunch is included at the cafeteria here. Then continue on through the Appalachian Mountains to Asheville, NC, where we will spend the night.

Thurs., Oct. 22: Charleston, SC (B) We travel to Charleston, SC, this morning. The Charleston area is rich in history, tradition and Southern culture. Upon arrival we will go to Patriot's Point and board the cruise out to Historic Fort Sumter. We will get off the boat and tour Fort Sumter, learning of the first shots fired here that began the American Civil War. Next we will go to the Charleston City Market, the cultural heart of the city. It is one of the nations oldest public markets with many places to eat and shop for local handcraft items and many shops. Mid-afternoon a local step-on-guide will join us on our motorcoach for a guided tour of Charleston, which has barely changed since it was founded in 1670. You will feel welcome with its charm and beauty. Then check into our hotel in Charleston, SC, for the night. You may wish to explore more of the Market area tonight as the evening is on your own to enjoy.

Fri., Oct. 23: Savannah, GA (B, D) In Charleston this morning, we'll tour the **Boone Hall** Plantation, which has been open to the public since 1956. The McRae Family purchased the plantation in 1955 and it was Mrs. McRae who furnished the house with antiques and began giving tours. Today, the McRae Family still owns the property, and they continue to make improvements to the plantation so that our visitors can experience what plantation life was like. As you tour each site on the plantation, our knowledgeable staff will help you understand the day to day activities of those who lived on plantations as well the history of the people who lived here at Boone Hall. Boone Hall Plantation was founded in 1681 when Englishman Major John Boone came to Charleston and established a lucrative plantation and gracious home on the banks of Wampacheone Creek. The family and descendants of Major Boone were influential in the history of South Carolina, the colonies and the nation. The McRae family is proud to present that history, covering over 330 years, on a daily basis. We will then depart for Savannah, GA. Savannah is known for its wealth of history and architecture that few American cities can match. We will check into our lodging for a two-night stay. This evening we look forward to an included meal at the Pirate's House. It is situated a block from the Savannah River and has welcomed visitors since 1753. It first was an inn for seafarers, then became a rendezvous for pirates and sailors. Then return to our hotel for the night.

Sat., Oct. 24: Savannah, GA (B, L) This morning a **local tour guide** will join us for a **City** Tour of Savannah, GA, learning about historical landmarks, houses, museum, squares, and parks abound in this beautiful coastal city. Then enjoy an included lunch savoring some great southern cooking! We will then return to the hotel for some free time this afternoon. Early this evening we will go to Savannah's City Market on River Street. Here enjoy a meal at one of their many restaurants and places to eat, plus visit the charming stores, antique shops, and delightful markets where you can find everything from art to souvenirs.

Sun., Oct. 25: Nashville, TN (B) As we leave the coastal area we will travel through Georgia to Atlanta, then continue on to Chattanooga, TN. Our destination is Nashville, TN. Nashville continues to uphold its Music City nickname, with over 130 music venues here that keep this city alive. After checking into our lodging we will go to downtown Nashville for a free evening to explore the "District," which is has music shows, great places to eat, and the country atmosphere Nashville is known for.

Mon., Oct. 26: Rockford, IL (B, D) Leaving Nashville this morning we will make our meal and comfort stops while visiting with our friends we have made during this tour. Our overnight is in **Rockford**, **IL**. We will treat you to a **Pizza Party** tonight.
