Sun., Oct. 4: Sister Bay, WI / Door County We take off on a fall tour to explore Door County, WI, and Mackinac Island, MI. Comfort and meal stops will be made along the way to Sister Bay, WI, located in Door County, where we stay for two nights at the Open Hearth Lodge.

Mon., Oct. 5: Sister Bay, WI / Door County (B, L, D) Today we familiarize ourselves with **Door County**, which has over 250 miles of shoreline and is home to orchards, artist colonies, and many interesting sites and attractions. We start with a stop at the Bjorklunden Chapel for a tour of the Stavkirke Church. In Sister Bay lunch is included at Al Johnson's Sod-roofed Restaurant with time for shopping. Following lunch we will do some more sightseeing



🌃 including a stop at a farmers market, a cheese shop, and a winery. Enjoy the evening here in the area known as the "Cape Cod of the Midwest" as we take in Pelletier's traditional Door 🤏 County **Fish Boil** in Fish Creek.

Tues., Oct. 6: Ludington, MI (B) This morning we will visit the Door County Maritime Museum in Sturgeon Bay to learn the maritime history of the area, and why the canal linking Lake Michigan to Green Bay is so important. Then we travel down to Manitowoc, WI. From here we board the S.S. Badger

Carferry for a leisurely 4-hour cruise across Lake Michigan. There are facilities for eating, outdoor decks for relaxing on, as well as indoor seating and more. We arrive in Ludington, MI, this evening where we will stay for the night.



Wed., Oct. 7: Mackinac Island, MI (B, L) A scenic days drive takes us through Traverse City and along Grand Traverse Bay to Charlevoix, and on to Mackinaw City, MI. From Mackinaw City we board Shepler's Ferry as it takes us across the Straits of Mackinac to Mackinac Island, MI. Once we disembark in Mackinac (pronounced "mack-in-awe") Island it will be like we have entered

a Victorian Village. This image is preserved and enhanced by a small population of residents that maintain the Island. No motorized vehicles are allowed on the island, so you will see many bicycles, horses, and carriages. Be sure to try some

of their famous fudge while here. Upon arrival experience the beauty and history of the Grand Hotel, where we'll have an included lunch. The Grand Hotel features the longest front porch in the world in a beautiful setting. The



remainder of the day is on your own to explore downtown and enjoy an evening meal on your own. Our lodging is at the quaint Island House Hotel.



Thurs., Oct. 8: Marquette, MI (B) This morning a horsedrawn carriage tour of the Island will show us many of the highlights and historical and unique landmarks. Later we will take the **Ferry** back to Mackinaw City and reboard our bus. Then, we cross the "Mighty Mac Bridge" and on

to Marquette, MI, for the night. Marquette is located on the shores of Lake Superior.

Fri., Oct. 9: Home (B) Homeward bound today routing through Duluth, MN, for lunch on your own in the Canal Park area. We hope you have enjoyed your tour to Door County and Mackinac Island, and so much more! Thank you for traveling with Utopia Tours.
