

Ark Encounter & Creation Museum

Spend two nights in Erlanger, Kentucky + BB Riverboat Cruise April 26–30, 2021 5 Days



Mon., April 26: Schaumburg, IL Join Utopia Tours on this fulfilling tour learning about the Amish of Indiana, and seeing Bible stories come to life at the Ark Encounter and Creation Museum. Our first day will take us to **Schaumburg, IL**, making meal and comfort stops along the way.

Tues., April 27: Erlanger, KY (CB, D) From Schaumburg we travel a few hours to **Indianapolis, IN**. Here we will visit the **Indianapolis Motor Speedway** where the Indy 500 is held. Enjoy time here at their Museum. From here we continue on through Indiana to Kentucky. Our next **two nights are in Erlanger, KY**. After checking in to our hotel we will take a short drive to Newport, KY, where we'll board the **BB Riverboat for a dinner cruise on the Ohio River**. Enjoy the sights as we cruise along this evening.

Wed., April 28: Erlanger, KY (CB, L) A short drive south brings us to Williamstown, KY, and the Ark Encounter. This life-sized Ark was built according to the dimensions given in the Bible and is the largest timber frame structure in the world. It's partly built by skilled Amish craftsmen, using standing dead timber. The Ark is an architectural and engineering wonder containing three decks of world-class exhibits within this unique attraction that brings to life the biblical accounts of Noah's Ark. It spans 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high. You will learn about the life of Noah, how he and his family could have fit in the Ark, how they cared for the animals on the Ark, and how his life was before the flood. A must-see, and is enjoyed by young and old alike. You will receive a voucher for lunch on your own at the cafeteria here. Later we'll return to our hotel for a night on your own.

Thurs,. April 29: Schaumburg, IL (CB, L) Leaving Erlanger we head west to **Petersburg, KY**, where we will visit the **Creation Museum**. The Museum brings the pages of the Bible to life, casting its characters and animals in dynamic form, and placing them in familiar settings. The museum allows for personal interaction with each of the 160 exhibits. You'll also find a Stargazer's Planetarium, Theater, the Garden of Eden, life-sized dinosaurs, a Petting Zoo, Botanical Gardens, Bookstore, Zip Line, and much more. A **lunch voucher is included** to enjoy lunch at the Museum. Our journey continues back through Indiana arriving in **Schaumburg, IL**, later this evening.
