Sat., July 24: Schaumburg, IL, area The simple beauty and awesome power of nature will surround us for the next week as we travel to Mackinac Island and Niagara Falls. Our first day out we meet and greet our new friends as we travel to the **Schaumburg, IL**, in the Chicago area for our overnight accommodations.

Sun., July 25: Dearborn, MI We depart Schaumburg this morning and travel across lower Michigan to **Dearborn, MI**. Included is an unforgettable Hornblower Niagara Boat Ride to the base of the falls. We will go to the Skylon Tower to experience the evening view of the Fall's incredible light show plus enjoy a meal at the Revolving Restaurant in the Skylon Tower. Niagara Falls is the collective name for three waterfalls that straddle the International border between Canada & the United States (Ontario & New York). It's located on the Niagara River, which drains Lake Erie into Lake Ontario and forms the highest waterfall in the world.

Tues., July 27: Niagara Falls, ON (L) A fun day is in store today as we cross the border to New York, and travel to **Lockport, NY.** We will spend some time at the renovated 1800's Canal town overlooking the Erie Canal. A **buffet lunch is included** while here. Following lunch we'll enjoy one of Niagara County's most popular tourist attractions - the **2-hour Lockport Locks & Erie Canal Cruise**, where we'll get on board for a relaxing and informative ride on the 19th Century engineering marvel

Tues., July 27 continued... which opened up the American Frontier - the Erie Canal. The Erie Canal remains the same as it was in the 1800's. Hand dug to connect the Hudson River with the Niagara River, the 363-mile Grand Old Erie Canal is truly a great engineering feet. 35 locks now allow larger vessels to travel across New York State. We will then return to **Niagara Falls, ON**, to our lodging and to have a free evening.

Wed., July 28: Frankenmuth, MI (D) Today we will cross the border from Ontario to Michigan as we travel to the ethnic city of **Frankenmuth, MI**, known as "Michigan's Little Bavaria." Here we will visit **Bronner's CHRISTmas Wonderland**, the World's largest Christmas store. The store is equal to 5-1/2 football fields in size, which is ample room for the many decorations and ornaments. Before settling in for the night we have an included **family-style chicken dinner at Zehnder's Restaurant**.

Thurs., July 29: Mackinac Island, MI (L) From Frankenmuth we travel north to Mackinaw City. Here we will board a ferry and cross the Straits of Mackinac to the quaint Mackinac Island. There are no motorized vehicles allowed on Mackinac Island. A horse drawn carriage ride will take us to our included lunch at the Grand Hotel. There will be time to meander down the "longest porch in the world" here and enjoy the views. After lunch a horse drawn carriage tour of the Island will detail the history and show us Surrey Hill Square, Arch Rock and Fort Mackinac. Our lodging is on Mackinac Island at the Island House Hotel. Enjoy your free time this evening for a meal (on your own) explore the Island, stroll the picturesque streets, and visit the shops known for their scrumptious fudge.

Fri., July 30: Rhinelander, WI Spend a relaxing morning on the Island before we **return to the mainland by ferry** and reboard our motorcoach. Then we cross the **"Mighty Mac,"** the 5-mile long Mackinac Bridge to St. Ignace, MI. We will make necessary stops today as we head to **Rhinelander, WI**, for the night. This evening enjoy the night on your own.

Sat., July 31: Home We return home today traveling through Wisconsin and into Minnesota, making the comfort stops along the way. Then, with the roar of the Falls and the creaking of Mackinac's carriage wheels still in our memories, we return to our friends and families.
