Fri., Feb. 14: Kansas City, MO **HAPPY VALENTINE'S DAY!** We begin our journey to a place that has grown in popularity for Midwestern people who are looking for relief from our winters-TEXAS. Join us on this tour, seeking sunshine as we head for New Orleans, the Texas Coast, and the Rio Grande Valley. We will make comfort and meal stops along the route. Our first overnight will be in the Kansas City, MO, area.

Sat., Feb. 15: Tulsa, OK (B) From Kansas City we head south a few hours to Pawhuska, AR. Here we will stop at the Mercantile, the Pioneer Woman's (Ree Drummond) shop where you can find bakery goods, restaurant, and store in a renovated 100-year old mercantile building. Lunch is on your own here, before we head west to Tulsa, OK. While going through the area you may see historic icons of the Route 66 era.

Sun., Feb. 16: Houston, TX (B, D) We leave Oklahoma and enter Texas this morning! Houston, TX, is our first overnight in Texas, the nation's fourth largest city. Our lodging is at the Drury Inn, here in Houston, TX. The Drury Inn's have their complimentary "Kick Back" food in the evenings.

Mon., Feb. 17: Corpus Christi, TX (B) Our day starts at the **Space Center Houston**, near Clear Lake City, TX. Here will take a tram tour the Center, seeing bits of history like the Saturn V Rocket, which did missions from 1967 to 1973; Astronaut training facility, mission control, and more. From here, beautiful **Gulf Coast** views await us as we travel to Corpus Christi, TX. The night is on your own to enjoy some



Tues,. Feb. 18: South Padre Island, TX (B) This morning we will visit the U.S.S. Lexington, which was built during World War II for the U.S. Navy, is the oldest remaining fleet carrier in

the world, and is also known as "the Blue Ghost." Then visit the Texas State Aquarium, with exhibits like Tentacles, Eagle Pass, Dolphin Bay, and more. After our morning visits we'll depart Corpus Christi. Over the next few days we travel south, exploring the Rio Grande Valley, one of the fastest growing communities in Texas, located in the southern tip of Texas along the Rio Grande River. Today, we will stop at the Texas King Ranch, which has more land than the state of Rhode Island, and is recognized as the birthplace of the American ranching industry. From here, an hours drive takes us to South Padre Island, TX, for a 2-night stay on beachfront property. Enjoy a relaxing evening on South Padre Island.

Later, we visit the **SAS** (San Antonio Shoes), with time to buy a pair at a reduced rate. You will have free time on the River Walk for shopping and a river taxi (cost not included in this tour) on the San Antonio River after we check into our lodging at the Drury Inn River Walk for two nights on this famous 21 block district.
